- Before each attempt, RE-CEHCK the security of the buckle to make sure it is holding properly.
   In addition, re-check the connections to the spotting rig, spotting ropes and swivel snaps and RE-CONFIRM comfort and position of the Twisting Belt with the athlete.
- NEVER use any spotting belt that does not properly fit the athlete or a belt that will not tighten snugly around the athlete's waist.
- NEVER attempt to alter the Twisting Belt in any way.
